Allow Him to put you under His microscope of love and remove anything that will hinder you and Him from having intimate fellowship with one another. Keep a notebook and begin to write down things He gives you each day.

God is wanting for His people to walk in a glory realm that will take us over or through any situation that arises. In order for this to happen we must prepare each day as if we are totally dependant upon Holy Spirit for each step we take. For the most part this is

totally contrary to everything we've been taught. The world teaches us to be independent people in order to be successful in life, but the Spirit of God says, "Depend on Me. Let Me lead you and teach you My ways and you will be blessed".

We must become so dependent upon the Lord that we are like a little child listening for Daddy's voice before we do anything. I know this is opposite to our worldly nature but God wants us to get all the things we've depended on in the past out of the way and put His Word in the forefront and His voice as the most familiar thing and only thing we follow.

Countdown to 2000 – What Are You Doing To Prepare?



Start preparing a list of things you use on a daily basis and from this make a shopping list of items you may want to have extras of. This is a good idea for anytime.

Y2K is everywhere we turn. As I have been dealing with this for the last few months, I have noticed other ministries are doing the same thing.

The word preparation keeps coming up in everything I am reading or hearing. The Lord obviously wants us to be ready for any storm that may come. For weeks now, the Lord has been saying to me, "Watch the storms". I do know that everything in the natural is connected to the supernatural.

I do not believe that God is the author of destruction, but I believe He uses situations to bring good. If we look at some of the storm torn areas, we also see places where neighbor has reached out to neighbor, sharing whatever they had. People came from everywhere to help the victims of these storms. Don't tell me that God can't use these storms to bring His children together.

Difficult times are coming upon the whole world and a great deal of the world has been in them for some time. The darkness that is coming will come upon the whole world. In the book of Exodus is recorded the plague of darkness that came upon the land of Goshen. Exodus 10:21-23 tells how in spite of the darkness the Israelites had lights in their dwellings. In Matthew, those who had built their houses on the rock of hearing and doing the Word of God had the floods come against them too, but their dwellings stood.

We need not be fearful. Isaiah 60:1-2 states that the darker it becomes the greater the glory will be for those who abide in the Lord. We don't need to fear the storms if our houses are built on the Rock. If we truly belong to the Lord, we own nothing. We are simply stewards of what He has entrusted to us. So if we lose all the material things, we've really lost nothing, for we had nothing to begin with.

We must just simply listen to the Holy Spirit on a day to day basis and He will instruct us as to what we are to do.

There are a few practical tips that we can follow for any emergency situation and this is a good thing in order to be prepared to even help others who may be in need.

1. Make a list of things you use on a daily basis. (hygiene items, medicines, cleaning supplies, etc.)
2. Keep your grocery receipts for one month and figure from that what you would normally buy for a weekly supply of food and staple items.
3. Make a basic menu for a week and prepare a list of items you would need to buy other than what you have on the other list.
4. Consider having extra water on hand for bathing, cooking and flushing the toilet. You can buy bottled water or you can take clean containers and store your own.
5. If you take medications on a regular basis, it might be a good idea to have extra on hand.
6. Have an alternative way of heating and a way for lighting.

These are just a few of the things on a list I have made. (Sounds like the early pioneer days doesn't it?) Each month as the Lord directs, I will share any new information I have with you and I believe this is going to be the greatest time in the church we've ever experienced. There is an anticipation in the air of knowing God is about to turn some things around and it will all be for our good.
