In Habakkuk 2:14, the Word says, “For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.”

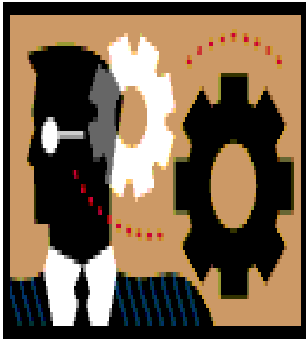
The Lord is getting ready to reveal himself to His Church as Captain and as a General of War as a Holy Warrior. He wants to reveal mighty things to us that
